Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of the class structure for the upcoming academic year.

From September 2025, we will have two classes with additional teaching staff to provide opportunities for small group learning.

To support this transition, we will be implementing a mixed-age class structure, with one class continuing to comprise of reception, Years 1 and 2, our Foundation Learning class. The other class will be Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 and be a KS2 class. While this is a change from our previous arrangement, it is not uncommon in small primary settings and can offer valuable opportunities for peer learning and collaboration.

Owls and Red Kites will have a joint registration session and then be split into their groups for a range of learning activities across the week.

We will be continuing with forest school for all groups across the week.

We will also have support for children with their emotional and social needs across the school with an Emotional Literacy Support Assistant and a qualified 'Thrive' practitioner.
