Dear Parents and Carers

As we continue on our amalgamation journey, it has been a busy and productive year, and I would like to thank all the staff, parents and carers for their support as our school continues on its journey.

All schools across Wales continue to be in times of change with reduced budgets, fluctuating pupil admission numbers, and changing cohort sizes, influencing their class organisation. At Ysgol Golwg Pen y Fan we have highly skilled and experienced teachers and support staff across all campuses who will ensure high quality learning and teaching, and social and emotional development is a priority. Every child will be at the heart of our school as we continue our learning journey together, realising our 'BEACON' vision together.

We will ensure there is a balance of ability levels. By grouping children vertically, they can become "experts" for their peers, nurturing thinking, problem-solving skills, vocabulary, and social skills.

The Curriculum for Wales is designed to be inclusive for all learners aged 3 to 16 and benefits the mixed-age approach ensuring consistency across settings and schools. It provides guidelines for developing curriculum expectations around assessment arrangements and it will allow for a broader range of teaching approaches. Cooperative learning between older and younger children will place fewer limits based on assumed ability, and the teachers will plan flexibly towards individual needs, enhancing the learning experience for all your children.

Our new curriculum vision will ensure a smooth transition for all learners from early childhood settings to school environments and beyond, supporting their progress in learning. We will ensure that effective planning and teacher expertise will maximise the benefits of mixed-age classes within the context of the Curriculum for Wales.

There will be two classes at Cradoc Primary Campus, three classes at Mount Street Infant Campus and five classes at Mount Street Junior Campus. We will ensure that all children have friendship groups in their new class. The Specialist Centres will support provision for both the infant and junior campuses, which is funded by Powys County Council.

We will continue the high standards and educational experiences across the campuses and we will enhance the learning and support your child/ren as they continue on their journey at Ysgol Golwg Pen y Fan.
